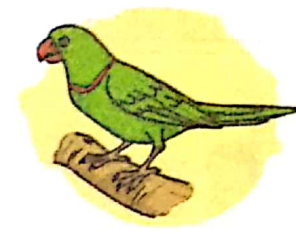

- * Some words name **things**. For example, ball and sun.

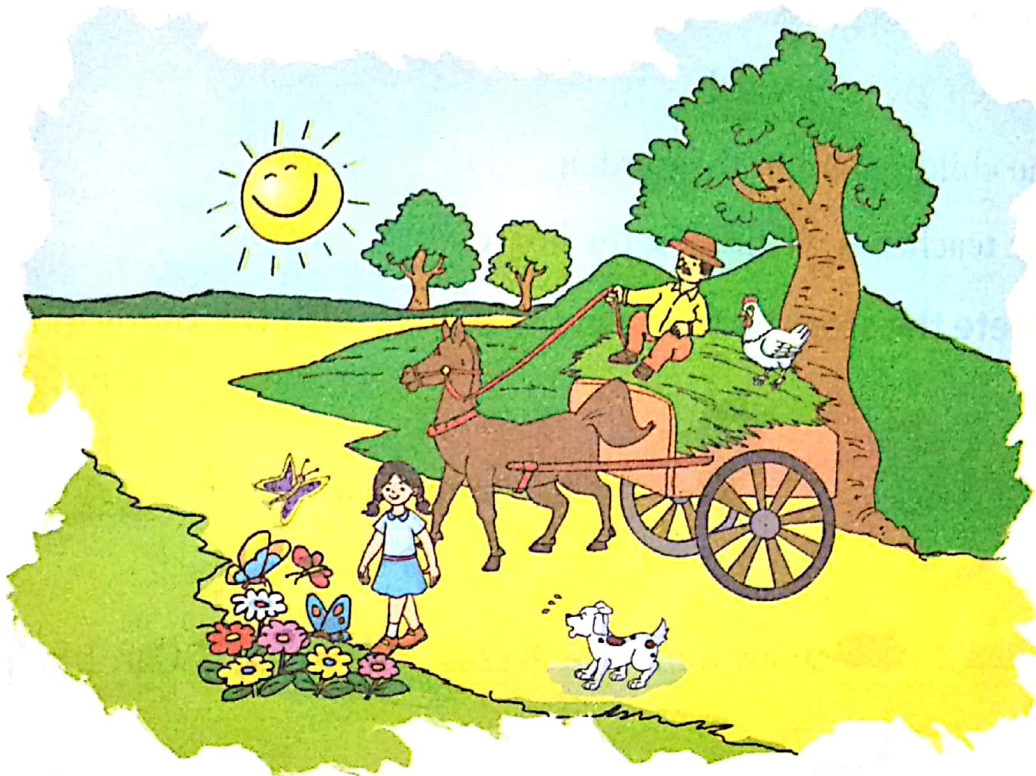
