Therefore today's class will be a practice session on the chapter of The Sentences and Types of Sentences.

A Sentence :

A Sentence is a group of words that makes complete sense.

- It must have words placed in the correct order.
- It begins with a capital letter.
- It ends with a full stop, a question mark or an exclamation mark.
- It must have a verb in it.

There are four types of Sentences.

1. Assertive Sentence.

A Sentence that makes a statement.

Example : This is a table.

Kalpna has not come back Home.

Such sentences end with a full stop (.)

2. Interrogative Sentences

A Sentence that asks a question.

Example : what is your name?

Isn't that your father?

Such sentences end with a Question mark (?)

### 3. Exclamatory Sentence

A sentence that expresses any strong emotion.

Example: Hurray! The exams are over.

Alas! The dog fell into the ground.

Such sentences end with an '!' (exclamation mark)

### 4. Imperative Sentence.

A sentence that requests or commands.

Example: Shut the door.

Please give me some food.

Note: • These are Ordering, Commanding and Requesting sentences.

• The subjects of these sentences may be hidden.
