Formation of Abstract Nouns

We can form abstract nouns

1. from adjectives:

brave — bravery; long — length; false — falsehood.

2. from verbs:

know — knowledge; choose — choice; judge — judgment.

3. from common nouns:

child - childhood; friend - friendship; slave - slavery.
