The objective of this question is to test your ability to express yourself in a well organised, clear, precise and accurate English.

Your composition should be logically planned and laid out well.

Dear Students,
There are many types of compositions, but today we will discuss about, 'Descriptive Composition.'

What is a descriptive composition?

A descriptive composition or essay describes particular people, places or things. The description could be real or imaginary. You visualize the picture and want to convey it to a reader as clearly and vividly as you see.

As you know that a painter uses his colours to re-create a scene, you have to use your rich vocabulary and beautiful style to create the picture.

Some descriptions may appeal to the reader's senses: sight, sound, touch, taste and hearing. When you describe a person you make him come out of the page in real flesh and blood and make him move his hands and legs and face, make him laugh

and weep, love and quarrel and do things that may compel one to love or hate the person.
