

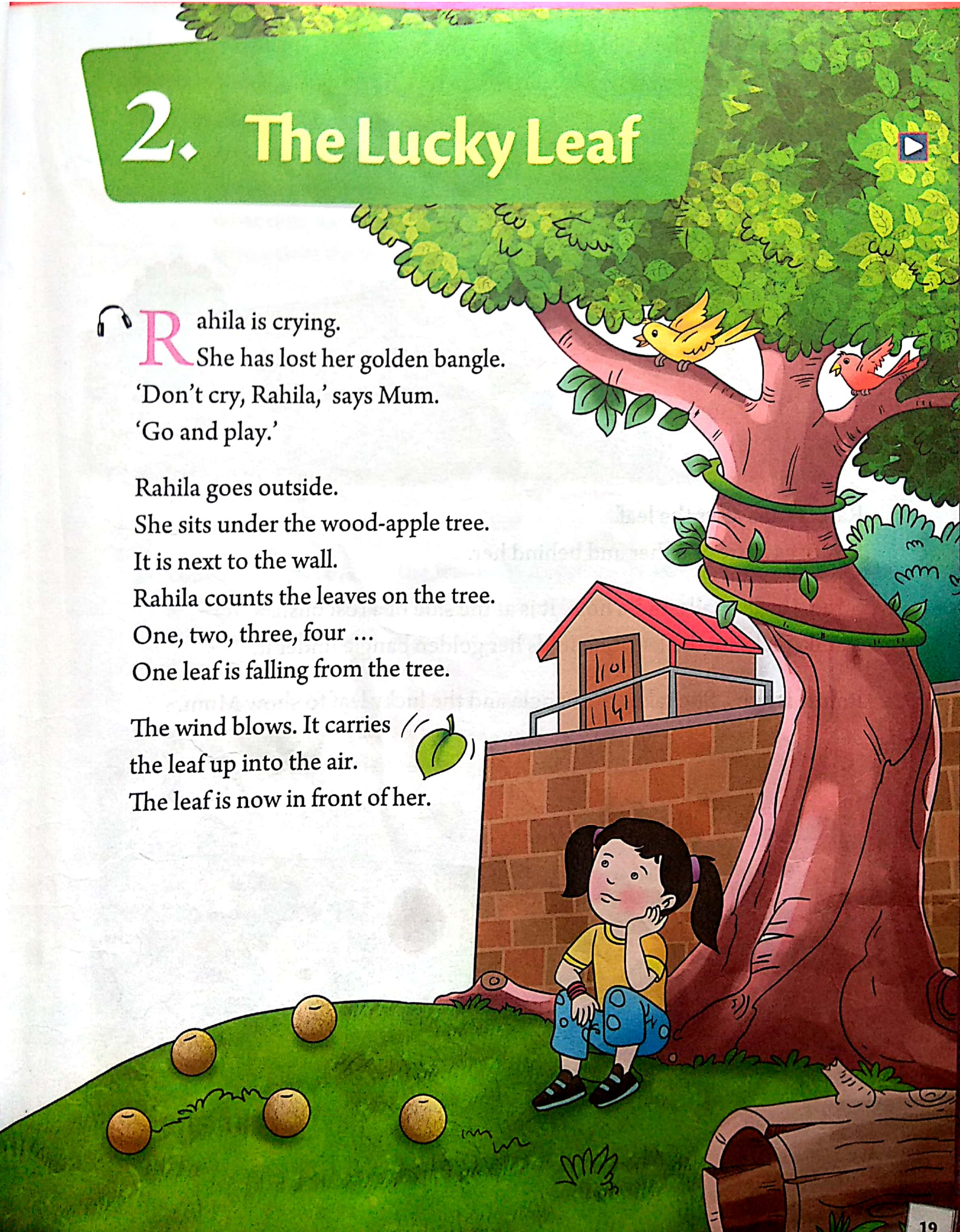


2. The Lucky Leaf

Rahila laughs. She takes the bangle and the lucky leaf to show Mum.

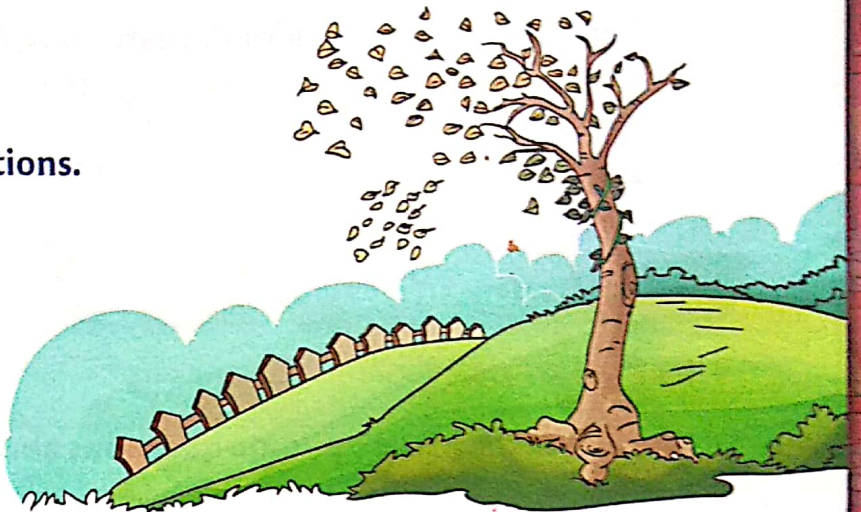
