English - I Singular and Plural

Nouns that end in *f* and *fe*,
are made plural by replacing
f and *fe* with *ves*.

Singular	Plural
leaf thief wife	leaves thieves wives

In nouns that end in a consonant
before the final *y*, the *y* is
replaced with *ies* to make
their plural.

Singular	Plural
baby family butterfly	babies families butterflies

In nouns that end in a vowel
before the final *y*, only an *s*
is added to make their plural.

Singular	Plural
toy monkey	toys monkeys





Some nouns do not follow any rules while forming their plural.

Singular	Plural
woman	women
child	children
ox	oxen
foot	feet
tooth	teeth
mouse	mice
man	men
person	people

Exception

Singular	Plural
radio	radios
piano	pianos
video	videos
hoof	hooves / hoofs
dwarf	dwarves / dwarfs
roof	roofs
chef	chefs

Some nouns do not change in their plural forms. For example:

- Sheep
- Luggage
- Knowledge
- news
- furniture
- deer
- fish
- money
- aircraft





Sometimes we use a plural noun for one thing that has two parts joined together. for example,

- Scissors
- jeans
- shorts
- Glasses
- trousers
- pants

Some plural nouns refer to a group of people, animals or things. for example,

- Clothes
- Stairs
- goods
