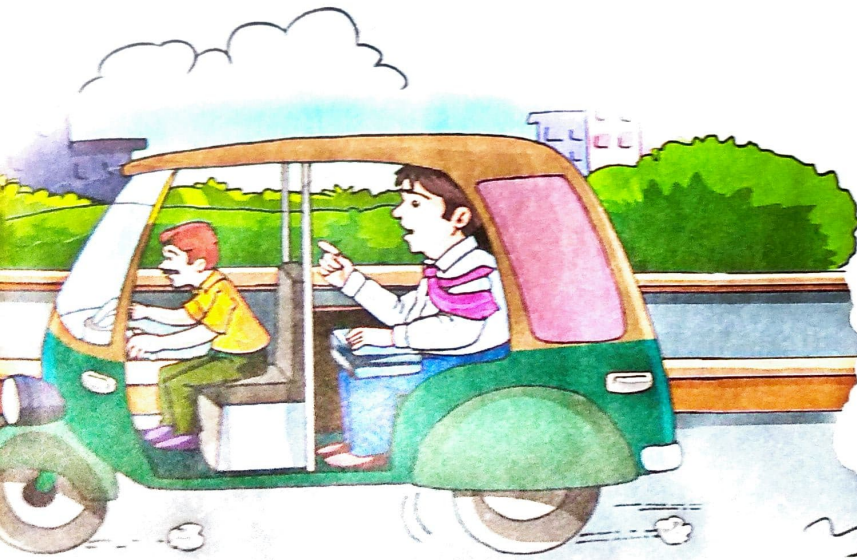
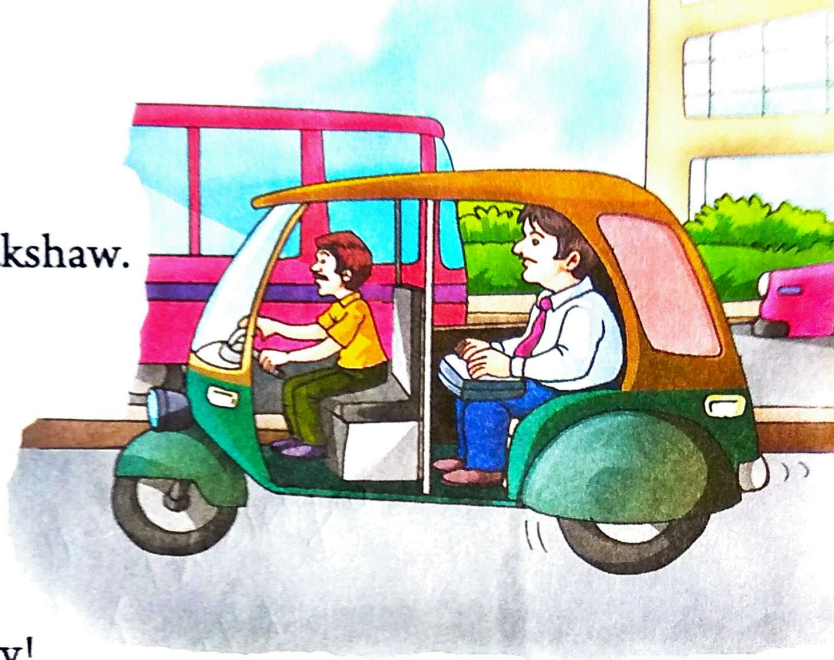


**R**aju is driving his auto-rickshaw.
