We wear new clothes and exchange sweets and gifts with friends and family. Some people burst firecrackers.


GURUPURAB

Langar means common kitchen where food is sérved in a gurudwara to all visitors.







NATIONAL FESTIVALS


Independence Day, Republic Day and Gandhi Jayanti are our national festivals. We celebrate them all over our country.

We hoist the national flag and sing patriotic songs.




We celebrate Republic Day on 26 January. On this day, a huge parade takes place at Rajpath, near India Gate in Delhi.
