

NOUNS: GENDER

- A noun that denotes a male is said to be of the masculine gender.
- Nouns like boy, man, brother, father, king, dog, etc., are of the masculine gender
 - A noun that denotes a female is said to be of the feminine gender.

 Nouns like girl, woman, sister, mother, queen, bitch, etc., are of the feminine gender.
 - Nouns like baby, child, parent, teacher, pupil, student, person, doctor, player, cousing friend, neighbour, bird, etc., are of the common gender.
 - A noun that denotes a non-living thing is said to be of the neuter gender. The word neuter means neither, that is neither male nor female.)

Nouns like book, pen, chair, car, wood, gold, school, etc., are of the neuter gender.

- Collective nouns like crew, flock, class, army denote collections of living beings. For example, class is a collection of students and students are living beings. Similarly, army is a collection of soldiers and soldiers are living beings too. But collective nouns are thought to be of the neuter gender.
 - Collective nouns are thought to be of the neuter gender.

Formation of the Feminines of Nouns

There are three ways of forming the feminines of nouns.

1. By adding -ess to the masculine:

The words author, poet and actor are now supposed to be of the common gend.

It is now common to refer to pet animals and domestic animals like dog, cat, contect, as he or she.
